Quids in are currently pricing up the cost of real Christmas trees for Cefn Bryn Brain, Councillors are aware that there are not enough working lights this year to go around all the wards.

Cllr. A. Campisi wished to donate her £150 renumeration towards Christmas Lights. The clerk mentioned the possibility that Ammanford Town Council may have spare lights they could borrow.

**<u>RESOLVED</u>**: To explore Ammanford further, to wait for prices of trees from Quids In, to get a price for a more adequate supply to the trees at Cefn Bryn Brain and the tree opposite the Bridge in Brynaman. Get costings for solar lights.

# **Christmas Competition.**

#### 10. Winter Planting costings.

The clerk advised that the winter plantings by Quids In, would cost the same as the summer plantings, which totalled £1302

**<u>RESOLVED</u>**: To go ahead with the winter planting this year, but to add two further locations as requested by councillors and to request more colour this year.

# 11. <u>Working with local councils in order to tackle issues with Carmarthenshire County</u> <u>Council.</u>

The clerk has spoken to the clerk of Cwmaman who advised that a committee had previously been set up to tackle County issues together. It is called the Amman Valley Councils and has not met since Ammanford Town Council took over the chair of the committee.

#### 12. Matters arising from the Wards

a.) Brynaman.

### b.) Cwarter Bach

It was brought to the council attention that there was drug dealing happening at a house on Cwmgarw Road, also speeding is an issue on Cwmgarw Road. H.T. to contact the Police.

S.T. mentioned the Community Police walk about coming up. Wicket Gate needs replacing on Mountain Road. Chase up CCC

### c.) <u>Llynfell</u>

Z.Ll- Dog fouling – there is only one bin. Speak to CCC regarding having more bins. Find out if CCC still have a dog warden?

Nets need to come down at CBB

There is water overflowing from the field above the tennis courts, culvert needs clearing, Glynog needs to authorise.

Tiles on the bus stop roof are coming down.

Panel missing from the other bus stop opposite.

**<u>RESOLVED</u>**: To email Carmarthenshire County Council regarding the issues raised.

A.C. has set up a Facebook page for the area

A.C. Mentioned the land behind the Ambulance Station (old school) and was interested in creating a Village Hub at the location.

Z.Ll. informed the council that according to the Land Registry records this land had been bought by Wales Ambulance.

# a.) Proposal for the Celtic Energy Fund

### 15. Donation for Remembrance Sunday.

There are two wreaths on order, one for Brynaman & one for Cwmllynfell. Additionally, this year Cllr R. Jones had asked if we could get crosses for the unmarked graves in the area.

**<u>RESOLVED</u>**: That the additional crosses be purchased and a donation of £105 be made to the Poppy Appeal.

#### 16. <u>Correspondance</u>

- i.) Confirmation from County that no election had been called and that the cooption notice could be put up. **Notice to go up next week for a two week period.**
- ii.) Donation Request from Brynaman RFC for money towards the firework display.

- iii.) Confirmation of meeting that has been set up between Celtic Energy and CBCC on the 15<sup>th</sup> November at the tennis courts in Cefn Bryn Brain at 10am.
- iv.) Request had come in from Rhodri James of Brynaman RFC that they be allowed to use Maes Elwyn pitch on Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> November

**<u>RESOLVED</u>**: Councillors were in agreement provided an official was able to say it was fit to play on, Bryn Rovers were notified and that they were aware there is no line markings down for them.

v.) An email had been received from a constituent complaining of dogs not being on leads at Upper Brynaman play park and requesting more notices be put up.

**<u>RESOLVED</u>**: to raise with the police on a walkabout and to look at purchasing more signs.

# 17. <u>To discuss and ratify the clerk position.</u>

It had previously been discussed that following the clerk completing the 6 month probationary period that the post be made permanent and that the position move
