I certify that I have completed the audit of the Annual Return for the year ended 31 March 2020 of **Cwarter Bach Community Council**. My audit has been conducted on behalf of the Auditor General for Wales and in accordance with the requirements of the Public Audit (Wales) Act 2004 (the 2004 Act) and guidance issued by the Auditor General for Wales.

Audit opinion: Qualified

Except for the matters reported below in my Basis for Qualification, on the basis of my audit, in my opinion no matters have come to my attention to give cause for concern that, in any material respect, the information reported in this Annual Return:

- has not been prepared in accordance with proper practices;
- that relevant legislative and regulatory requirements have not been met;
- is not consistent with the Council's governance arrangements; and
- that the Council does not have proper arrangements in place to secure economy, efficiency and effectiveness in its use of resources.

Basis of Qualification

Accounting Statement

I am unable to conclude whether or not the Accounting Statement properly/fairly presents the Council's receipts and payments/income and expenditure and financial position:

- The Council did not maintain sufficient accounting records and was unable to provide me with information to enable me to complete my audit.
- I have not been able to obtain evidence that the Council approved the Accounting Statement as required by the Accounts and Audit (Wales) Regulations 2014.

Annual Governance Statement

The Council has failed to comply with its statutory responsibilities set out in the Accounts and Audit (Wales) Regulations 2014:

- The Council has not prepared and published an Annual Governance Statement
- The Council did not make arrangements to secure an adequate and effective system of internal audit
- The Council has not published on its website information it is required to publish by the Local Government (Democracy) (Wales) Act 2013
